

principal's ponderings

Kia ora Parents.

Firstly, I do apologise for those who enjoy a hard copy of our newsletter. We were unable to print the newsletter this week due to our Junior Campus network server breaking down. It has served us for a great number of years but has officially taken its last breath. We are currently looking at the options that will enable us to go forward with confidence.

Secondly, it is great to be back at Hillview. You may not have realised but last week I toured the North Island with ten other Christian School leaders (a mix of principals and deputy principals) from around the South Island. Last Monday night we travelled to Wellington. For the next four days we drove up the North Island visiting nine Christian Schools and

finished in Auckland on Friday night. Two schools were independent (both attempting to integrate as their current Attendance Dues per child hover in the range of \$6500 - \$8000 per child) and the rest were fully integrated.

I am thrilled that Christ-centred education is alive and well in Aotearoa meeting pupils who are confident and content in living out their faith in the Lord Jesus



We visited the following schools:

Maranatha School (Upper Hutt), Longburn Adventist School, Cornerstone Christian School (Palmerston North), Hastings Christian School (Hastings), Sonrise Christian School (Gisbourne), Chapman College (Rotorua), Bethlehem College (Tauranga), South City Christian School, and Hamilton Christian School (Hamilton). The number of pupils at each school ranged from approximately 50 pupils through to approximately 1600 pupils. Currently there are over 14000 pupils who attend Christian Schools throughout New Zealand. 3000 of these pupils attend one of the 13 Christian Schools scattered throughout the South Island.

The purpose of the trip was simply to bless each school, to learn from them, and to network amongst the leaders in the touring party. It was extremely

successful and we hope to visit some more schools further north in two years' time. Sometimes I think we feel the need to always travel overseas to conferences or invite international people to attend our conference days in order to receive the best professional development. While there is nothing wrong with this (it should continue to be part of our development programme), we should never neglect or avoid the rich opportunities before us. To learn from one another within our own country of New Zealand as we seek to grow and sharpen our knowledge and skill is something special and should always be encouraged.

There were several highlights on the trip and I plan to share these with staff in the next 3-4 weeks. One special moment is captured in the photo below when Y1-10 pupils from Chapman College welcomed us onto their school with a formal powhiri including waiata, mihi presentations, and finishing with a

hongi. The school sang a beautiful waiata around the verse from Micah 6:8



using the words to "Act justly, love mercy, and walk humbly with your God." It was very powerful and touched each of our hearts. I am thrilled that Christ-centred education is alive and well in Aotearoa meeting pupils who are confident and content in living

out their faith in the Lord Jesus. I am also grateful that we continue to live in a country that promotes parental choice and provides opportunities for pupils to attend a special character school. May we never take this for granted and be thankful for what we have.
